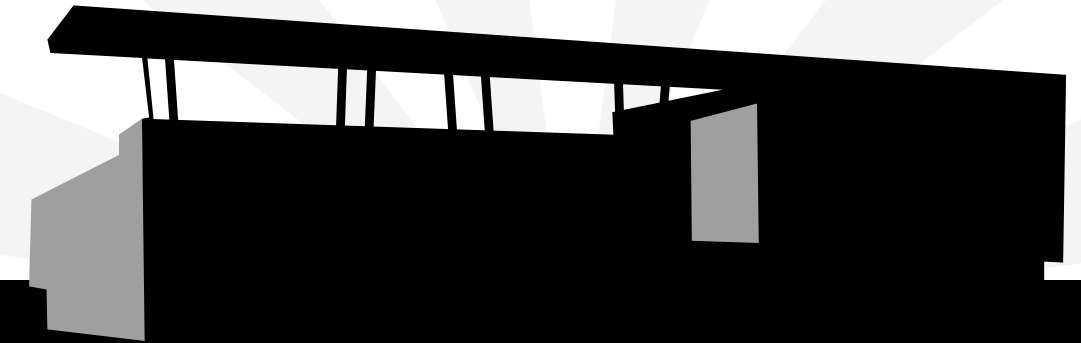


Grangemouth High School

FAQs

Where will I park and what entrance should be used?

Parking will be available in our car park and in our bus bay. We anticipate that the event will be busy, please take care and be mindful of families moving beside cars. Families should enter through our pupil entrance beside the bus bay.

Should pupils and younger children attend?

Yes, this is very much a family event and there will be activities to entertain young and old.

Will there be refreshments available?

Tea/coffee stations will be available across the school, there will also be some snack options available in the Joint (Food Hall) area at a small cost to go towards school funds.

Can someone help me to book sessions?

Yes, if you face any difficulty in booking on to sessions, please contact our school office and someone will be able to help you.

FAQs

The session that I want to attend is full, will there be other opportunities to take part?

We hope that everyone will be able to access what they would like to visit. If, however, there is anything that you would have liked to experience that becomes fully booked, please let us know and we will look to put on further sessions at a later date.

Will I be able to speak to my child's teachers?

Most department areas will be represented during the evening and staff will be available to answer questions about courses and provide information on pathways. However, given the volume of families attending it may not be possible for staff to provide detailed individual feedback on progress. Please get in touch with your child's House Team to follow-up on any individual questions or concerns.

Do I need to bring anything?

Depending on what you plan to visit, you may wish to wear clothes suitable for baking, cooking or physical activity and bring swim wear for pupils participating in the inflatable pool sessions.
