Numbers in the survey show number of individual responses, NOT percentages.

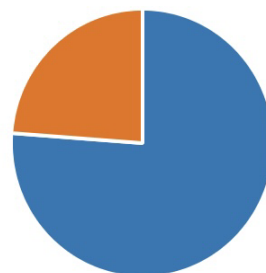
It was easy to log in and start my appointments

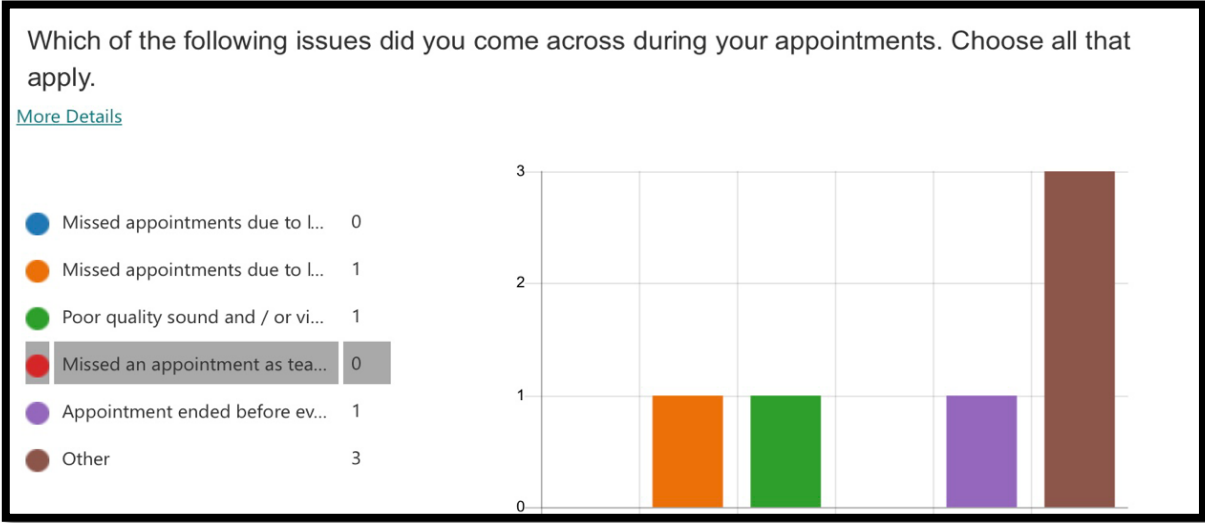


I had no significant issues or problems during my appointments.

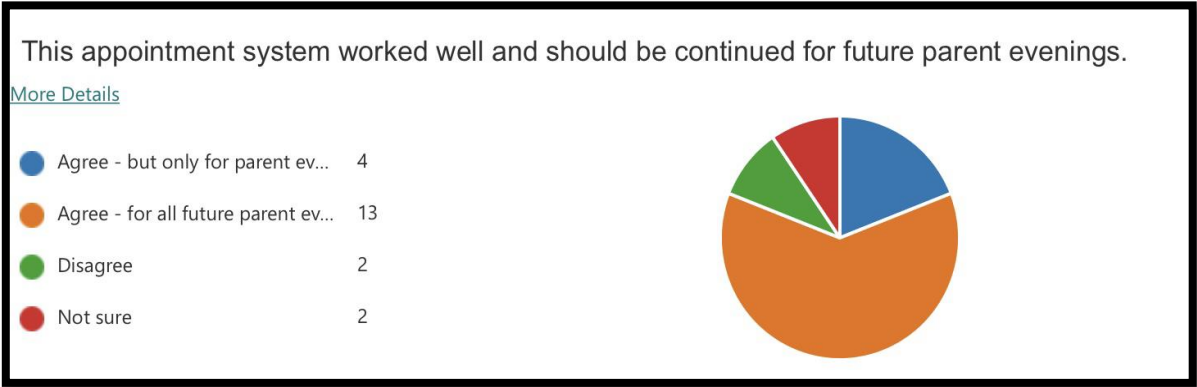


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Key

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Comments:

The online system worked really well and great how no one ran over time due to timer cut off (which in school meetings can run late) although a little more than 5 min app would be a little better and if the extra time not needed then you (or teacher) are able to end chat.
Slightly longer timings would be better to fully discuss pupil progress and progression. Even if split over 2 nights like primary school.
I thought the parents night went smoothly and i actually enjoyed sitting with my son hearing and speaking about his progress.

I think in general it worked OK. Had a couple of issues where 1 teacher was almost a couple of minutes late joining (which doesn't sound bad but when appointment is only 5 minutes it really matters) and another teacher who I think was on school WiFi and the audio and video froze so wasn't able to have the appointment. The biggest issue was the appointment length, it was a struggle to cover everything in the 5 minutes and I found myself with unanswered questions. Think it would be good to have an email address for the teacher or department next to each appointment so that any follow up questions could be asked. I know I could contact the school for this (which I will be) but would be more relevant to do this to each department at the time.
